RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. All entries on official forms to the Cricket Pavilion, Ibstone between 6.30 and 8.00 pm on Tuesday 30th July or Wednesday 31st July. Postal entries should be addressed to Mr. M. Smith, The Brambles, Ibstone, Bucks. HP14 3XZ. Entry forms are also available on line at www.ibstoneshow.org.uk and must be returned by 8.00pm on Wednesday 31st July.

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 8.00 PM ON WEDNESDAY 31st July.

2. All entries to be grown or made by the exhibitor, excluding Classes 15, 16, 45, and 92 where additional materials may be used.
3. Ornamental fruits, berries and leaves are allowed in Classes 15, 16 and 45.
4. Entries for the Art Classes must be original work only.
5. Domestic and Handicraft Classes are judged in line with the Women's Institute Guide for Exhibitors and Judges.
6. In Domestic Classes fill all jars to the brim to allow for shrinkage. Use jars and lids with no commercial markings. Always put full date on jar, i.e. day/month/year. A waxed circle is not needed when a screw lid is used.
7. Handicraft Exhibits must have been made within the previous three years. No exhibit accepted from previous years entries.
8. If there are fewer than 6 entries or entries are not up to standard in any one class, prizes may be withheld by the Judges, whose decision is final.
9. Exhibits to be staged between 8.00 am and 10.00 am on the day of the Show. Exhibits and cards must remain until 4.15 pm; those not removed by 4.45 pm, or not indicated 'not for sale', will be sold by auction.
10. Prize money to be collected from the marquee between 2.30pm - 3.30pm.
11. While all reasonable care will be taken, the Committee will not be liable for any loss or damage which may occur.
12. An exhibitor may stage more than one exhibit in any class. One prize only in any class to one exhibitor. Points awarded: 3 for 1st prize, 2 for 2nd, 1 for 3rd. In the event of a tie, the exhibitor with the most 1st prizes wins the Cup.
13. All entries in the PHOTOGRAPHIC CLASSES must have been taken by the exhibitor, but may have been processed professionally. Entries must be prints, either colour or black and white. Prints must not exceed 250mm x 200mm in size excluding mounts (if any). NAME AND ADDRESS PRINTED ON REVERSE.
No more than two entries from one person in any one class.
14. Where any age limit is specified, the exhibitor's age on the 1st August 2019 is applicable.
